

Gala (Kidd's D-8) Apple

Malus sp.

Medium sized. Conic to round shape. Golden yellow skin with reddish-orange blush. Flesh is firm, crisp, sweet and juicy with excellent flavor. Stores well. Will take summer heat.

Gala's size, mellow flavor and thin skin make them a perfect choice for kids.

Ripens: Late August to Early September or earlier in warmer climates.

Developed in New Zealand in the 1920's as a hybrid of the Golden Delicious Apple. Requires 500 hours chilling below 45° F

Cold hardy to U.S.D.A. Zone 5.
