*Malus sp.*

Medium to large, round. Skin green overlaid with bright red. Firm, crisp, fine texture, juicy, sweet-tart, good flavored, white flesh. Good aroma. Excellent for fresh eating, cooking and baking. Very heavy production in mild winter areas.

Requires 300-500 hours of chill below 45°F.

Ripens: Mid-August to Mid-October.
