

# Honeycrisp™ Apple

*Malus sp.*

Excellent round apple variety, with 60-90% scarlet red over yellow background. Well-balanced sweet/tart flavor. Texture is similar to a crisp watermelon or Asian pear. **Said to be “explosively crisp, fun to eat” and very juicy.** Excellent keeping quality. Consistent production. Fruit size is very large.

Licensed by the University of Minnesota. Planted widely in Michigan, Wisconsin, New York, and Washington. Not good for hot areas. Can sunburn in southwest.

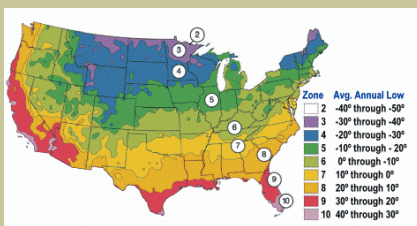
Requires 800 hours chilling below 45°F.

Ripens: Around September  
20-25 just before Red  
Delicious.

Grows to height of 20 feet with  
a spread of 20-25 feet.

Cold hardy to  
U.S.D.A. Zone 5.
