

McIntosh (Double Red) Apple

Malus sp.

Large, round-oblate fruit. Thin, tender, smooth skin deeply blushed with bright red. White flesh, sometimes veined with pink, firm, fine, crisp, tender, juicy.

Excellent for cooler areas and home use - especially applesauce.

Trees are extremely hardy and productive.

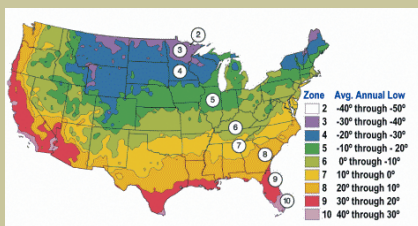
Partly self-fertile.

Pollinate with Red Delicious.

Requires 900 hours chilling below 45°F.

Ripens: September
