Large, round-oblate fruit. Thin, tender, smooth skin deeply blushed with bright red. White flesh, sometimes veined with pink, firm, fine, crisp, tender, juicy. Excellent for cooler areas and home use especially applesauce. Trees are extremely hardy and productive. Partly self- fertile. Pollinate with Red Delicious.

Requires 900 hours chilling below 45°F.

Ripens: September

Cold hardy to U.S.D.A. Zone 4.
