Fruiting Japanese Apricot (Ume) Single Pink

Ripe fruit has red blush over orange skin. 3/4" to 1" in diameter.

Attractive, showy single pink blooms from late January to Early February.

Both blooms and fruit are prolific.
Earliest to bloom indicating low chill hours for mild winter areas.

Fruit ripens mid May to early June.

Mature height is 15-20 feet with a spread of 15-20 feet.

Requires 300-400 hours chilling below 45 F.

Cold hardy to U.S.D.A. Zone 7. Sunset Zones: 7-24, 28, 31, 33







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
