

Tilton Apricot

Prunus sp.

Very large, heart shape. Light orange skin. Firm, flavorful flesh. Bears heavy crop.

Excellent for freezing, canning, and drying.

A vigorous tree, resistant to late frosts.

Requires 600-700 hours chilling below 45°F.

Ripens: Late June to Early July.

Cold Hardy to
U.S.D.A. Zone 7.
