

Bing Cherry

Prunus avium sp.

#1 popular sweet cherry. Large. Dark red skin. Rich, sweet, firm, purplish flesh. Excellent for eating, canning and preserves.

Needs pollinizer such as Black Tartarian, Van, Rainier, or Stella. Will not pollinate with Royal Ann.

Requires 900 hours chilling below 45°F.

Ripens: Early to Mid Season, around Mid June in Visalia, CA.

Cold Hardy to
U.S.D.A. Zone 6.
