

GA 866 Jujube

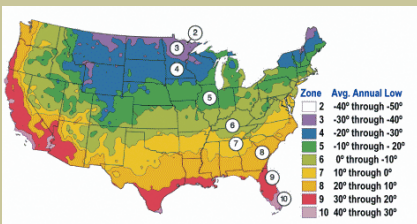
Ziziphus jujuba

Shiny reddish-brown, date like fruit. Sweet apple flavor. Fruit is noteworthy for its remarkably high sugar content. When candied and dried they resemble dates. Also, can be made into a delicious ice cream. The fruit is 1½-2 inches long, elongated and plump. Ripens close to Lang. Needs hot summer for fruit to ripen, especially good in desert areas. Attractive shiny leaves and rugged, picturesque bark. An outstanding selection from Chico Research program.

Ripens mid to late September.

Mature height is 15-20 feet with a spread of 15-20 feet.

Cold hardy to U.S.D.A. Zone 5.
