

Lang Jujube

Ziziphus jujuba

Sweet apple flavor. When candied and dried they resemble dates. Also, a delicious ice cream can be made.

The fruit is 1½ inches long, distinctly pear shaped. Best when picked fully ripe off the tree.

Needs hot summer for fruit to ripen. Produces very well in desert areas.

Attractive shiny leaves and rugged, picturesque bark.

Ripens mid September earlier than Li.

Mature height is 15-30 feet with a spread of 15-20 feet.

Cold hardy to U.S.D.A. Zone 5.
