

Sugar Cane Jujube

Ziziphus jujuba 'Sugar Cane'

Extremely sweet fruit with an apple texture and flavor makes this a favorite!

Medium sized fruit which can be round to elongated.

Attractive shiny leaves. Spiny plant (spines far smaller than other Jujube varieties) but the fruit is worth the spines!

Drought tolerant. Good in hot desert regions.

150 hours chilling.

Ripens mid to late September.

Mature height is 15-20 feet with a spread of 15-20 feet.

Cold hardy to U.S.D.A. Zone 5.
