## **Bosc Pear**

Pyrus communis sp.

A favorite for eating and cooking.

Large, long necked, tapering fruit. Heavy russeting on green or yellow skin. White, juicy flesh with rich, slightly acid flavor.

Does better with pollinizer such as Bartlett, Comice, Seckel or other pears.

Requires 700 hours of chill below 45°F.

Ripens: September to October.

Cold hardy to U.S.D.A. Zone 5.
