The Cool Climate Pear Combination was created for those areas with 900 or more hours of chilling.

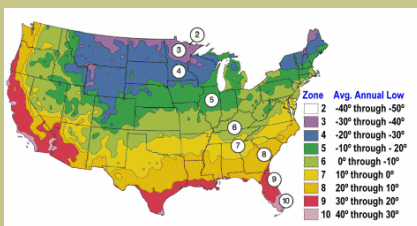
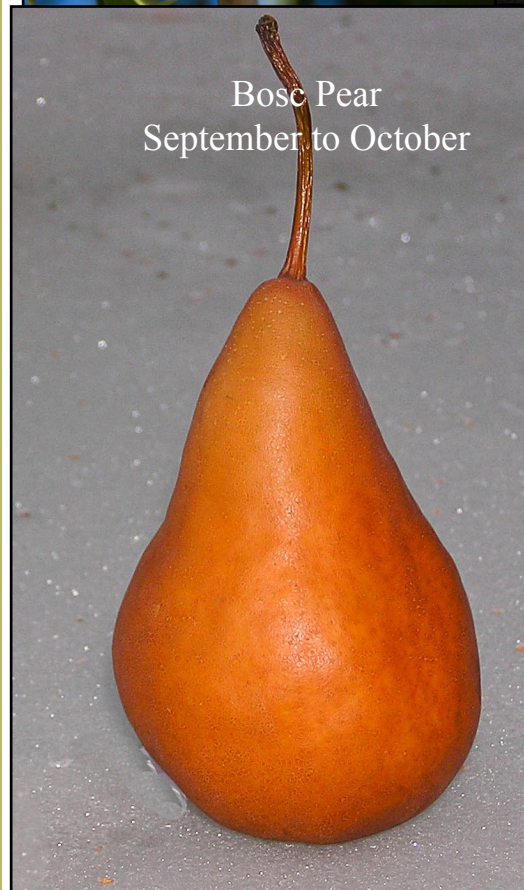
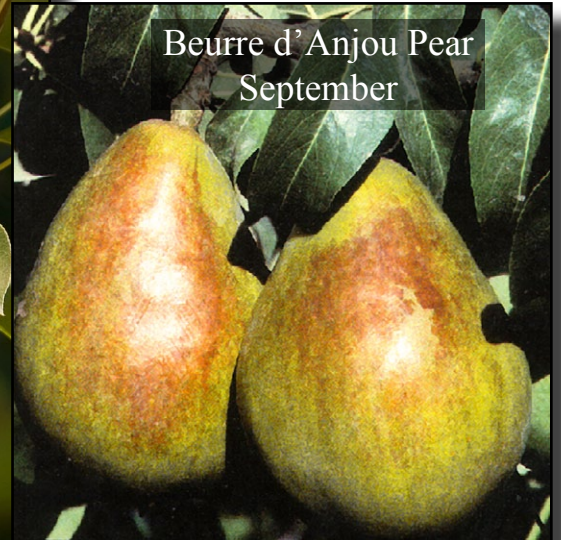
The tree is made up of three to four of the following varieties:

Bartlett: The #1 most popular pear in the world. Ripens: August.

Beurre d'Anjou: Buttery texture does justice to its French name. White, fine flavored flesh. Ripens: September.

Bosc: Large, long necked, tapering fruit. A favorite for fresh eating or cooking. Ripens: September to October.

Surecrop: Resembles Bartlett in looks and taste. Consistent bearer. Prolonged bloom ideal for late frost areas. Ripens: September. Cold hardy to U.S.D.A. Zone 5.
