

Hood Pear

Pyrus communis sp.

Large. Smooth, yellow-green skin. Buttery textured flesh containing a few small stone cells. Has a sweet mild pear flavor.

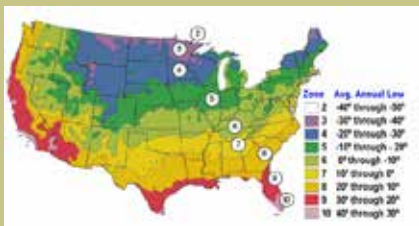
Tree is upright and spreading.

Highly resistant to fire blight. Moderate resistance to leaf spot.

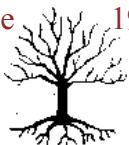
Requires 150-250 hours of chill below 45°F.

Ripens: Mid to late July.

Cold hardy to U.S.D.A. Zone 8
