Needs pollinizer.

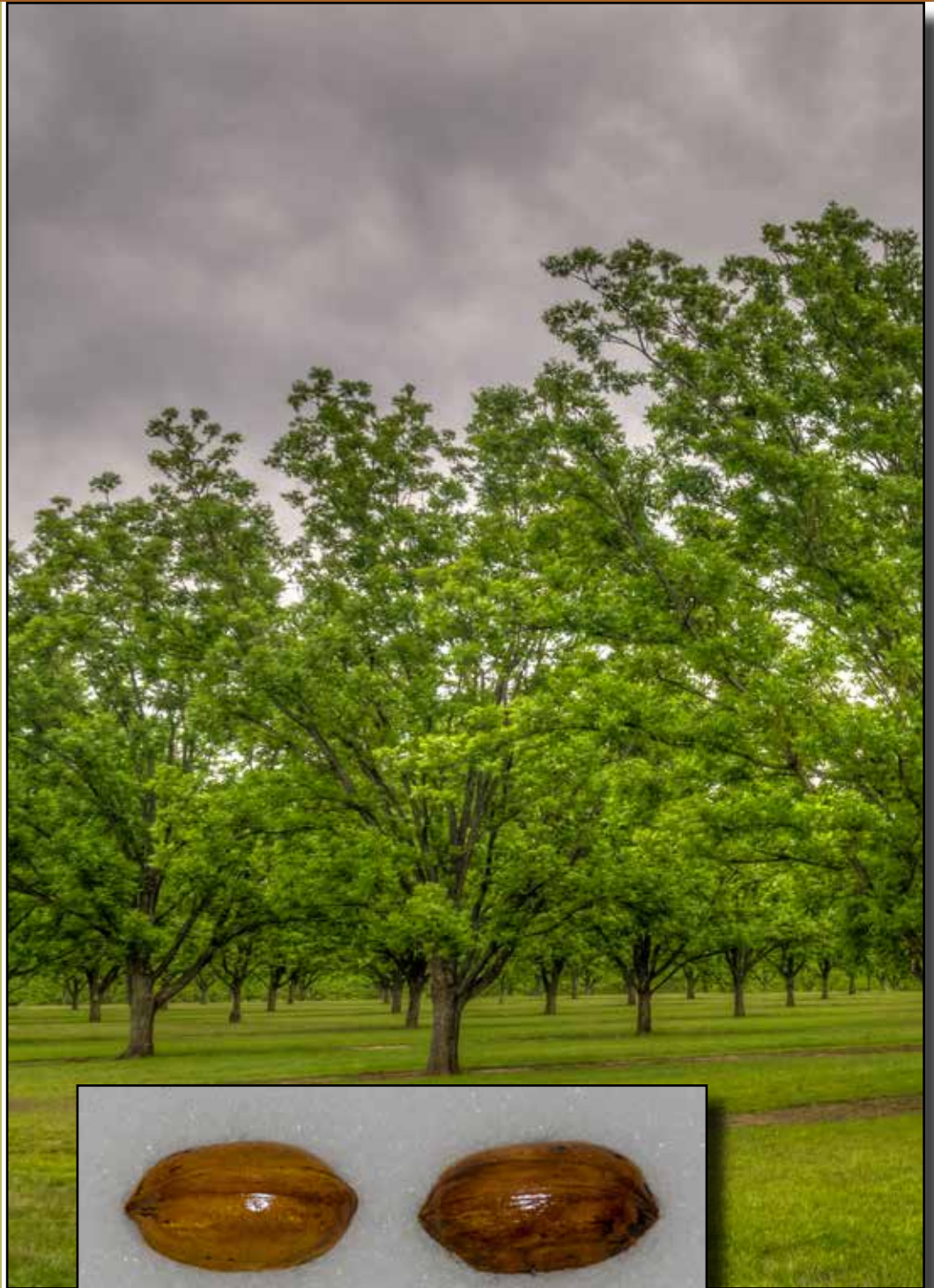
Late pollen shedding.

Does well in arid West and humid East climates.

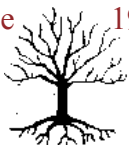
Large tree and good for landscaping.
