Diospyros kaki Tsuru-No-Ko'.

Highly productive tree producing medium to small, elongated fruit. Very tasty, sweet, brown flesh. Nonastringent when ripe.

Foliage is attractive lime green in early spring, dark green in summer with orange fall color.

Ripens: Late October into Early November

Medium tree height with an approximate mature height of 20-25 feet and a spread of 10-15 feet.

Cold hardy to U.S.D.A. Zone 7.
