

# Tanenashi Persimmon

*Diospyros kaki sp.*

A very productive tree that bears at young age. A beautiful, impressive sight when fully loaded.

Fruit is medium - large sized, cone shaped with brilliant orange-red skin.

Flesh is Astringent until soft. Seedless. Excellent for cooking and drying.

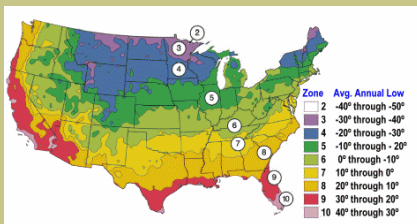
Ripens: October.

Mature height is 25-35 feet with a spread of 18-25 feet.

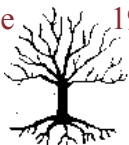
Requires less than 200 hours chilling below 45° F.

Cold hardy to U.S.D.A. Zone 7.
