

Late (Improved) Santa Rosa Plum

Prunus salicina

Large. Purplish-Crimson fruit with blue bloom. Firm flesh, deep amber to dark red near skin.

Rich, pleasing, tart flavor.

Ripens:
Early August.

Self-fertile. A good pollinizer for other plums.

Requires 500 hours of chilling below 45° F.

Cold hardy to
U.S.D.A. Zone 5.
