

Satsuma Plum

Prunus salicina sp.

A favorite because of its great taste.

Large, solid red skin and flesh. Firm, rather juicy.

Fruits in mild winter areas but also cold hardy for colder climates.

Needs a pollinizer, such as Santa Rosa or Beauty.

Ripens: Late July to Early August.

Requires 300 hours of chilling below 45° F.

Cold hardy to U.S.D.A. Zone 5.
