

# Weeping Santa Rosa Plum

*Prunus salicina* sp.

Large. Purplish-red skin. Firm flesh, yellow to dark red near skin. Rich, pleasing flavor.

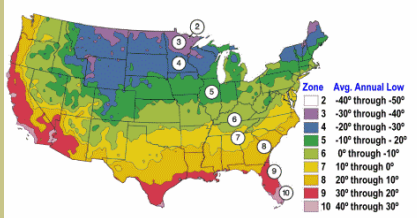
Graceful weeping branches. Tree is natural semi-dwarf. Mature Height 8-10 feet.

Self-fertile.

Fruit ripens in July, two weeks after Santa Rosa.

Requires 400 hours chilling below 45° F.

Cold hardy to U.S.D.A. Zone 5.
