

Orange (Apple) Quince

Cydonia oblonga sp.

Medium to large. Round - some call this the "Apple" Quince.

Golden skin. Orange yellow, tender flesh.

Good for cooking, pie fillings, candies and jelly.

Leading fruiting Quince in the Northeast for its earlier ripening.

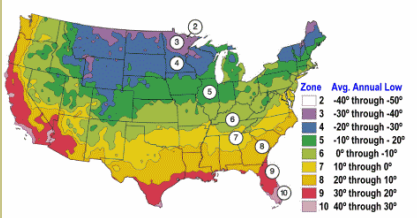
Self fertile.

Ripens: September into October in the NE.

Mature height is 12-15 feet.

Requires around 100 hours of chilling below 45° F.

Cold hardy to U.S.D.A. Zone 5.
