Cydonia oblonga sp.

Large, elongated. Lemon yellow skin. Flesh is tender, highly perfumed, with excellent flavor.

Good for cooking, pie fillings, candies and jelly.

An old Turkish variety, often used in colder climates.

Self fertile.


Ripens: September.
