


Champanel Grape

Vitis labrusca cross

Large. Black grapes with white bloom. Thin but tough skin with tender, juicy flesh. Good table grape. Large loose cluster. Ripens evenly, not given to cracking or dropping. Very resistant to heat and drought. Goes well in any soil including alkaline and black soils. Adapted to north central Texas. Cane pruning.

Ripens: Early July.

Cold hardy to U.S.D.A. Zone 6.
