hardiness and vigor.

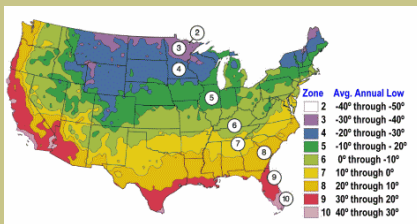
Produces abundant
