


# Lomanto Grape

*Vitis labrusca vinifera cross*

Medium to large, round. Black, thin skin. Flesh is melting and of excellent quality. Juice is claret red. Seeds are small and few. Cluster is conical, compact, and above medium size. No rot or mildew. Leaf is medium, with little pubescence. Vine is vigorous and prolific. Good in alkaline soils and hot climates. Used for juice, jelly, eating out of hand, and in the making of a unique red wine.

Ripens: Mid-June.
