

Perlette Seedless Grape

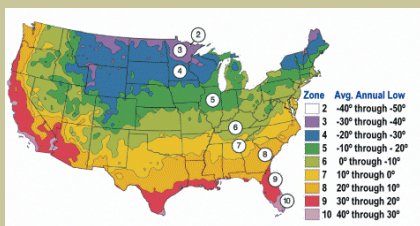
Vitis vinifera

An early season grape, the Perlette is light in color - almost frosty green with a translucent cast; the large berries are nearly round and seedless. One third larger than Thompson Seedless. Used mainly for eating fresh. Perlette means "little pearl" in French.
