

# Red Globe Grapes

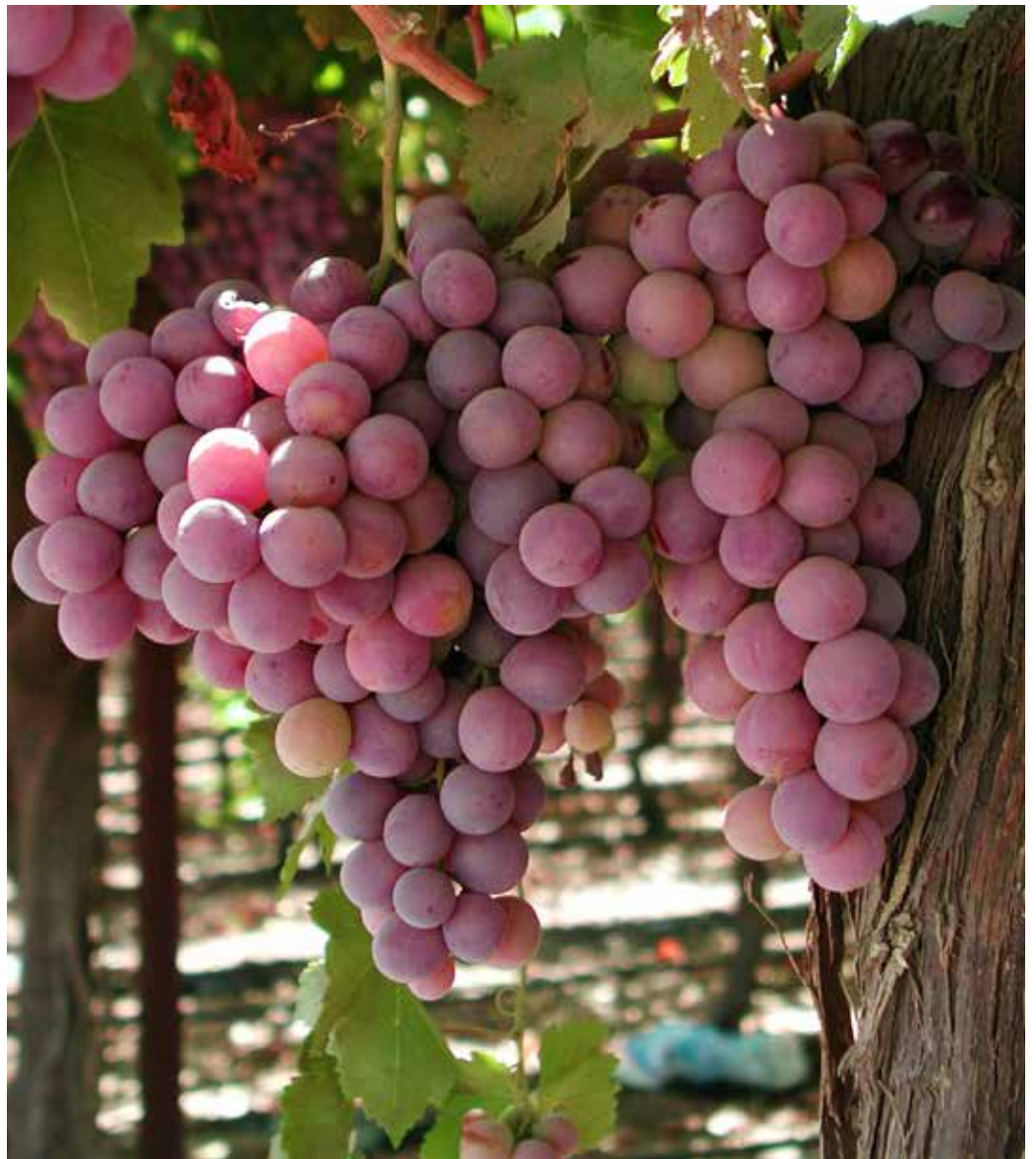
*Vitis vinifera sp.*
