

Chinese 'Evergreen' (Drake) Elm

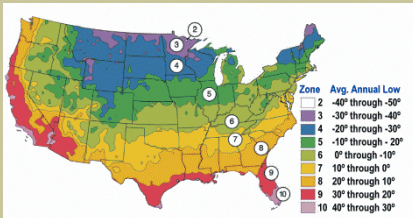
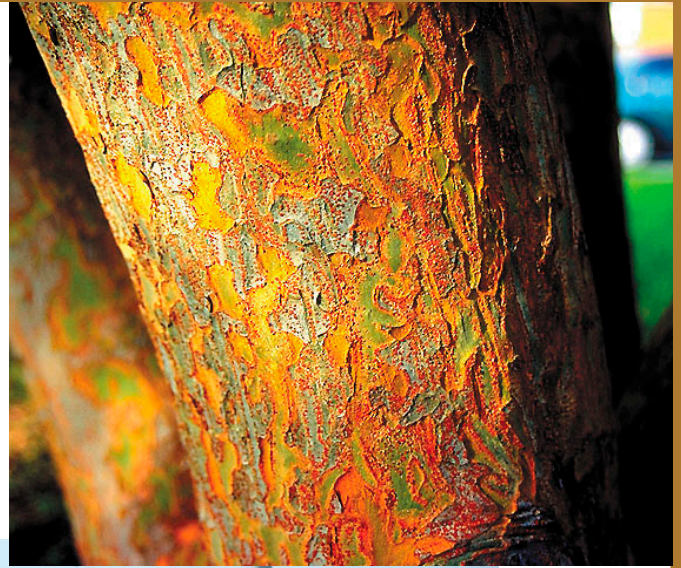
Ulmus parvifolia 'Drake'

Fast growing, often reaching a height of 30 feet in five to six years. Form is generally spreading with long, arching branches.

Lacebark. Leathery, oval-shaped leaves up to 2 inches long and 1 1/2 inches wide. Drake has a smaller leaves and is more weeping habit than seedlings.

Mature height is 40 feet with a spread of 40 feet.

Cold hardy to U.S.D.A. Zone 6.
