

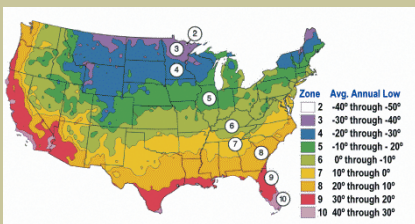
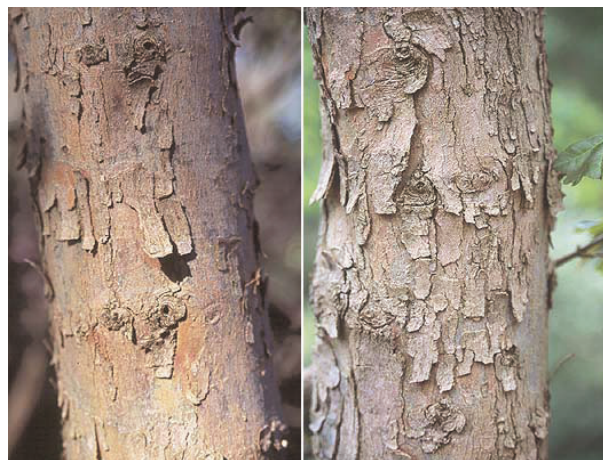
Trident Maple

Acer buergeranum

The Trident Maple is an oriental deciduous tree. It is very tolerant to pollution, which is why it is often grown in cities and towns. The leaves each have three lobes, which have smooth edges. They are reddish in the spring, turning to green in the summer and orange to yellow in the autumn. The trunk is thick when mature, and the bark peels in a similar way to the plane tree, thus exposing orange areas underneath. The Trident maple is considered hardy, however it will need frost protecting in the winter due to its roots having a high moisture content.

Grows to a height of 20-35 feet and a spread of 15-20 feet.

Cold Hardy to U.S.D.A. Zone 5.
