

Red Oak

Quercus rubra

Also known as Northern Red Oak and Eastern Red Oak.

Large, fast grower (for oaks). Broad-headed tree. Leaves are very large.

Color turns from rich dull green to dark red in fall, turning brown before dropping.

Tolerant of air pollution. Prefers acidic soils.

Height: 50-75 feet x 50-75 feet wide.

Cold hardy to U.S.D.A. Zone 4, many say 3.
