

Shumard Oak

Quercus shumardii

Similar to Scarlet Oak. Tolerates moist, acidic, poorly drained soils.

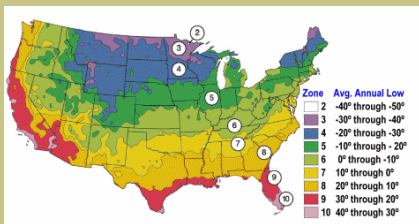
Moderate growth rate, eventually attains height of 50-90' with 40-50' spread.

Bark is gray, ridged, & furrowed.

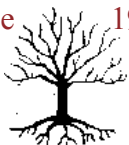
Leaves are bright green with deeply cut lobes.

Fall foliage turns a stunning red.

Cold hardy to U.S.D.A. Zone 5, some say 4.
