

VALLEY OAK (CALIFORNIA WHITE OAK) *Quercus lobata*

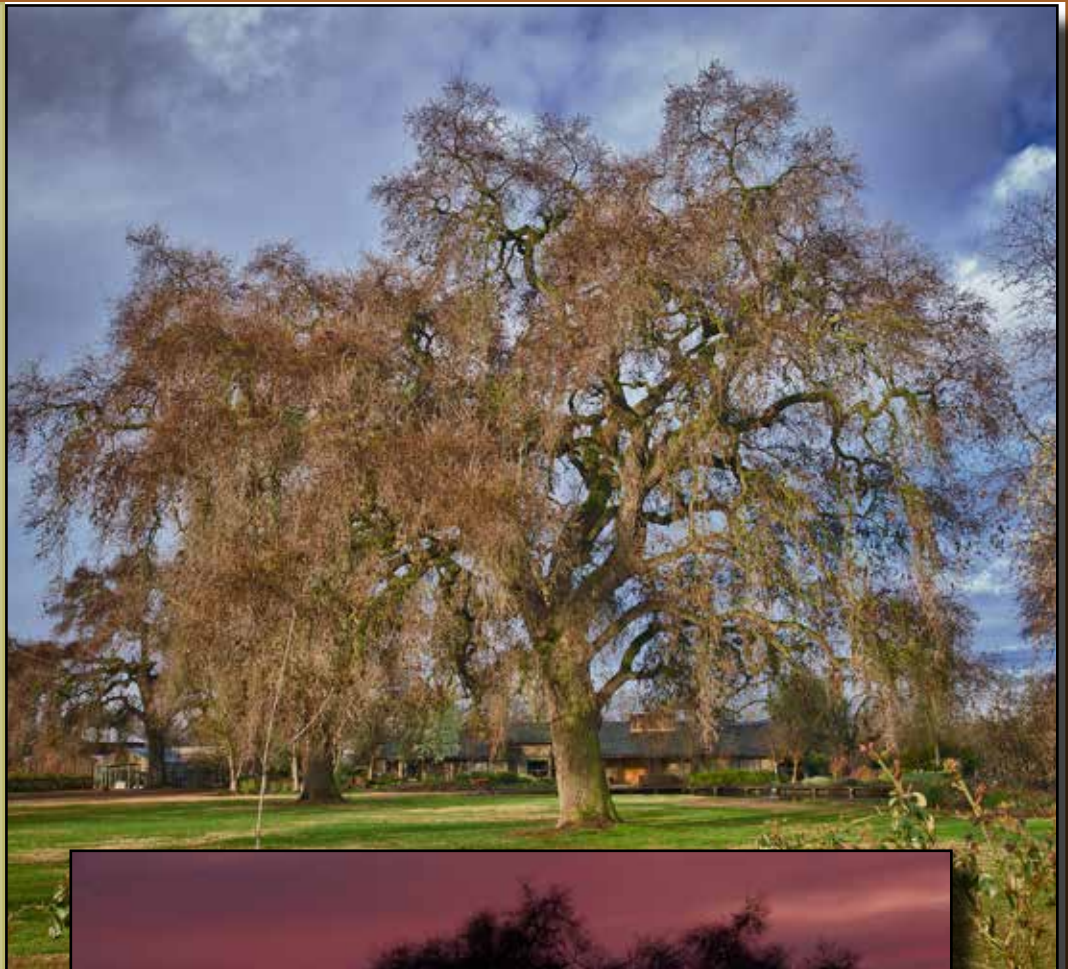
Grows into one of North America's largest oaks.

Native to California, mostly in the hot interior valleys and foothills.

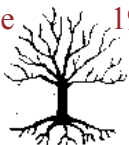
Irregular, spreading growth makes it a frequent subject of photos against the winter sky.

Requires regular water source - found often along creeks.

Cold hardy to U.S.D.A. Zone 7.
