

# Persian Laceleaf Lilac

*Syringa x laciniata*

Graceful foliage and a form great for use as a foundation plant.

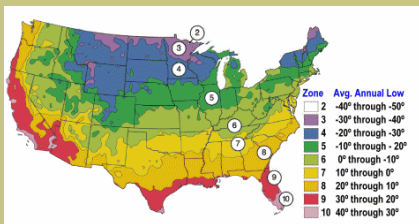
Foliage is unlike any other lilac. Small dainty leaves are pinnately cut into 3-9 leaves. Gives a very “soft” look and feel which is why this lilac is so well liked.

A profusion of fragrant, pale lavender flowers in loose, 3” long panicles. Subtle fragrance.

Disease resistant. Very heat tolerant.

Mature height is 5-8 feet with a spread of 5-8 feet.

Cold hardy to U.S.D.A. Zone 4.
