

Wisteria floribunda *'Longissima Kyushaku'*

It is hard to pronounce but hard to forget once you have seen it in full splendor.

This vine likely has the longest clusters of flowers. Older plants can bear racemes in excess of 6 feet long! Mauve colored blooms.

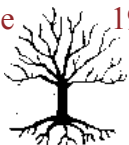
Can be grown as a vine or trained upright into a standard (tree).

Cold hardy to
U.S.D.A. Zone 5.
